An Update re Adopt a Choral Scholar or Adopt a Pipe, Pedal, or Piston–Our choral scholars and our organ are being adopted! So far, we have received \$1780 towards adopting various organ pipes and \$270 towards adopting choral scholars. These totals along with money collected at the concert bring the total raised to \$2909.47. Which part of the organ would you like to adopt or would you prefer to adopt a choral scholar? Please refer to the pink sheet which is on the table at the back of the church. All the “adoption fees” will go towards the Choral Scholar Fund or the Organ Maintenance Fund as specified.

The spear grass needs to be pulled out in many places. We are trying to leave the poppies to self seed and so we don't want to weed eat where they are but the spear grass is mixed in with the
